Waxing

Adolf Biecker (508 W. Lancaster Ave., Strafford, 610-687-4750; 210 W. Rittenhouse Sq., Third Fl., 215-735-6404) is dedicated to making depilation as organic as possible: The plant-oil-enriched Aveda waxes offered here are derived from a wood-sap base and made without synthetics or colorants, to minimize irritation (from \$12).

Exfoliation

The invigorating 45-minute Oriental Body Glow (\$95) at the Main Line's Asian-inspired **Ame** (111 Waynewood Ave., Wayne, 610-995-2631) involves a blend of completely edible, natural ingredients: honey, herbs, peppermint leaves, and chamomile.
